

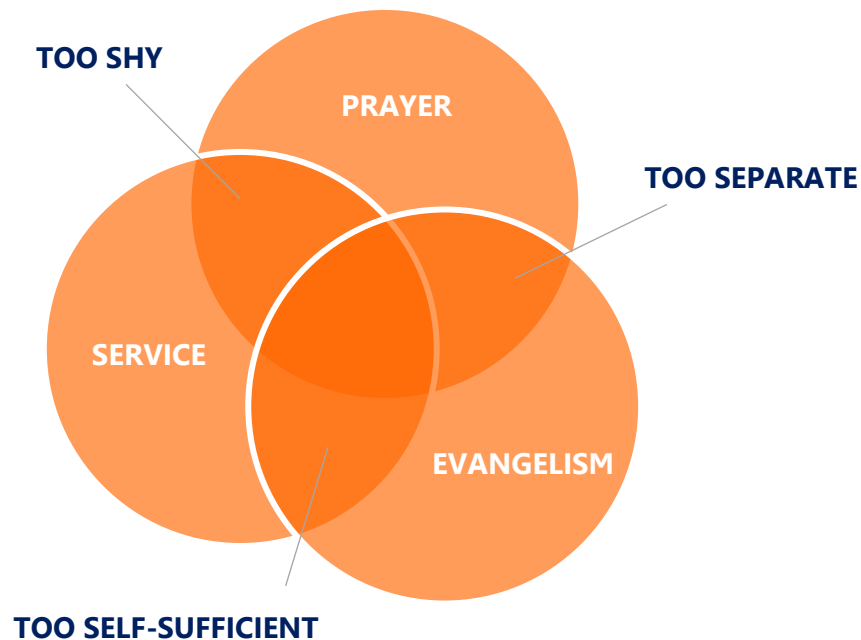
3 NECESSARY COMPONENTS OF MATURE GOSPEL MOVEMENTS

Prayer, Service, and Evangelism are the three core components of gospel movements. A robust gospel movement takes place when all three of these core components are lived out through the Church in united, holistic and sustainable ways.

Local leaders' passions, city needs, and varying seasons of a gospel movement are just a few factors that can create a propensity to focus more intently on one or two of these core components over other(s) components.

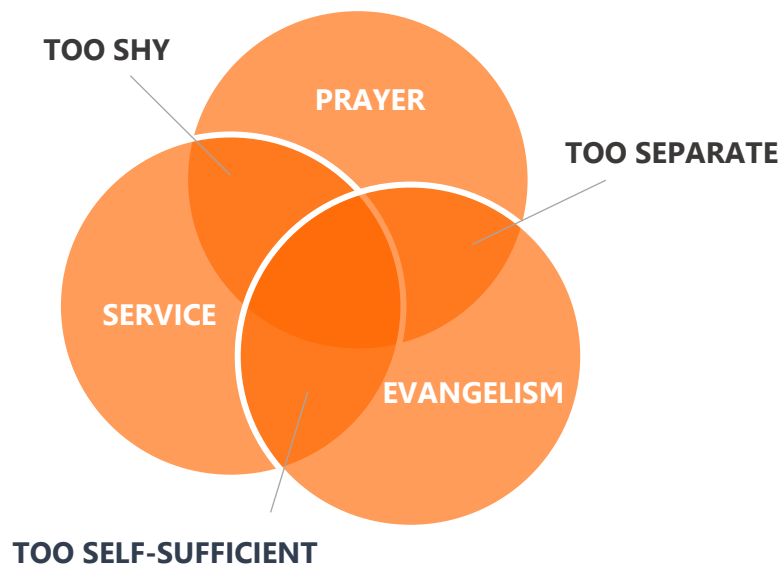
