

# EVANGELISM TEAM PHASES

**DO EVANGELISM TOGETHER + REACH YOUR ENTIRE CITY.  
FORM AN EVANGELISM TEAM. HERE'S HOW:**



## 01 Identify Potential

Is your city a place where an E-Team could flourish? Here are a few things to look for: strong unity between churches, a widespread desire for more gospel conversations, and some existing collaborative leadership between churches and/or parachurch groups (though not necessarily around evangelism).

## 02 Vision Cast

If your city has a strong foundation for collaboration, our LPA team will connect with one or a few key local leaders about the history and formation of E-Teams. These key leaders need to be in a place to lead the E-Team or refer another local leader. If there is interest from these local leaders about forming an E-Team, we'll move on to the next phase.



## 03 Advise Local Leadership

Next, local leaders read the *Evangelism Team Guidebook* and brainstorm with LPA about strong prospective team members and what the first meeting(s) could look like. The first meeting is scheduled.

## 04 Form an E-Team

The first E-Team meeting takes place. Woohoo! If possible, an LPA team member is present to support.



## 05 Craft the Vision

Your local E-Team drafts a collaborative action plan with strategic group goals and establishes a core team within the E-Team to execute or delegate the action plan. We'll help coach you along the way and even connect the E-Team leader(s) in your city with peers across the country for peer learning.

## 06 Own the Vision

Your E-Team is actively implementing their collaborative action plan which was formed in the previous phase, meeting on a regular basis (recommended quarterly), and the E-Team leader stays in regular communication with LPA to share updates and receive encouragement. Peer learning among E-Team leaders also continues.
